MCCURDY MISSION SCHOOL

Five individuals from SUMC joined Richland Hills & Gordon UMC, along with churches from Colorado and Arizona at McCurdy School for a week of work and fellowship. McCurdy is a National Mission Institution of the UMC owned by the Women's Division (UMW) located between Santa Fe and Taos. In 2012 the school, pre-school through 12th grade, will celebrate 100 years of ministry and education to the children of the Espanola Valley. With limited funds the school is a beacon of light. McCurdy has a 0% drop out rate compared to the public high school which has a 50% drop out rate. Of the thirty one 2011 graduates thirty will attend college and one joined the job corps, receiving over \$475,000 in scholarship money. We had a wonderful and
