REFLECTION QUESTIONS

A key part of understanding and applying God's Word is to read it reflectively. The questions below are not exhaustive, but they provide the framework as you seek to be rooted in and refreshed by Jesus through Luke's Gospel.

As you get started, protect yourself from distractions as much as you can. Stay away from your phone, email, social media, or TV. If possible, get alone in a semi-quiet place. Grab your Bible, a pencil, and a notepad. Pray for God's Spirit to give you understanding of what you read, to help you know and love God more, and to change you through it.

1. What attributes, character qualities, or aspects of Christ's person do I notice in this passage?
2. Does this teach me something about the work of Jesus? Does it shed light on his mission and ministry?
3. What does this reveal about the heart of Jesus toward people, including sinners and sufferers?
4. Who is Jesus interacting with in this passage? How does he treat the individuals or groups, and why does he do this? How is it different from the way others might treat them?
5. What is Jesus teaching in this section?
6. Are there any commands to obey, or ways to follow and reflect him? Does Jesus model how to treat others?
7. What about this passage causes me to worship, love, or appreciate Jesus? How can I praise and thank him?
8. In this text, is Jesus fulfilling anything promised, alluded to, or drawn from the OT? How so?
